## **ANNUAL SPEND**

The Company will spend not less than 1.5% of the average Net Profits of the Company made during the three immediately preceding financial years. The surplus arising out of the CSR activity will not be part of business profits of the Company. The Committee will meet as required, to discuss and review CSR activities and Policy.

### **Scope of Functions of CSR Committee:**

- To publicize the CSR Policy and initiatives
- To carry out workshops to increase employee awareness on various projects
- Organize other activities as directed by the Board of Directors of the Company and/or as deemed appropriate and expedient by the Committee for the furtherance of CSR objectives of the Company
- Implement programmes & activities proposed to be undertaken by the Company



## Activities

A list of CSR projects/programmes which the Company plans to undertake during the implementation year will be laid down before the Committee at the beginning of each year, specifying modalities of execution in the areas/sectors chosen and implementation schedules for the same.

Identification of projects and the executing agency/NGO will be made, inter-alia, by assessing the following objective: Sharing Connectivity With All is a commitment in three areas:

**A.** Innovating sustainably - By 2021, we will innovate so that 100% of products have an environmental or social benefit.

**B.** Producing sustainably - By 2021, we will reduce our environmental footprint by 60 % whilst bringing connectivity to one million new consumers.

**C.** Developing sustainably Employees: GX International employees will have access to health care, social protection and training, wherever they are.

The CSR Committee will review the activities of the Company and will provide progress update to the Board of Directors every year months or at such other intervals as deemed fit. Any or all provisions of the CSR Policy would be subject to revision/amendment in accordance with the Act on the subject as may be issued from relevant statutory authorities, from time to time.
